Parents are responsible for the safety of their children at all times. It is a condition of entry that everyone who attends or competes at any of our events DO SO ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- 2. Please take ALL rubbish home with you or put in the bins provided
- 3. DOGS to be kept on a lead at all times & not allowed to foul the showground
- 4. All competitors must be adequately covered by their own third party insurance. (IT IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT EACH EXHIBITOR INDEMINIFIES THE SWSHS and/or ANY OFFICIAL OR GUEST OF THE SWSHS AGAINST ANY CLAIM ARISING FROM ANY ACCIDENT / OCCURRENCE IN WHICH THE EXHIBITOR OR HIS EXHIBIT ARE INVOLVED)
- 5. Stallions/colts should be adequately bitted, under control and not exhibited by anyone under the age of 16.
- 6. All livestock must be supervised at all times by a person over 16 years of age and experienced in the handling of such livestock
- 7. No mucking out of horseboxes / trailers on the showground. Horses / ponies tied to the outside of lorries / trailers MUST NOT BE left unattended.
- 8. Hard hats & suitable footwear to current standards to be worn at all times when mounted & must be fastened.
- 9. All Exhibitors to be in the Show field with their exhibits by 10.00am. No exhibits to be removed from the Show field before 3.00pm without written permission being first obtained from the Show Secretary
